James and Kathy Laidler received a call that three children in the foster care system were going to be separated if the Laidlers didn't take in this sibling group. It wasn't just any sibling group, either. These children were relatives of James. Ten-year-old Keegan, nine-year-old Leah, and eight-year-old Rosa were about to be taken from their family and split up. But God, in His sovereign plan, didn't allow that. Instead, He allowed them to spend nine months with the Laidlers.

"My mom got a subscription to *Keys for Kids* for us. Every day at breakfast we would read the story. Then, on the drive to school, we would talk about it," Kathy explained.

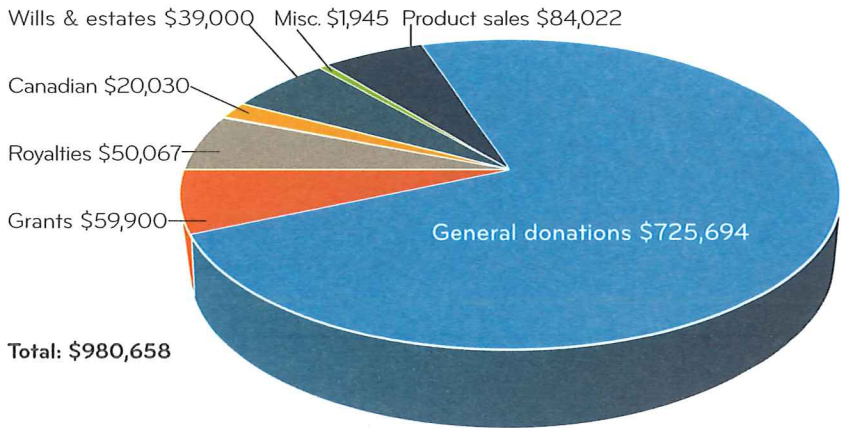

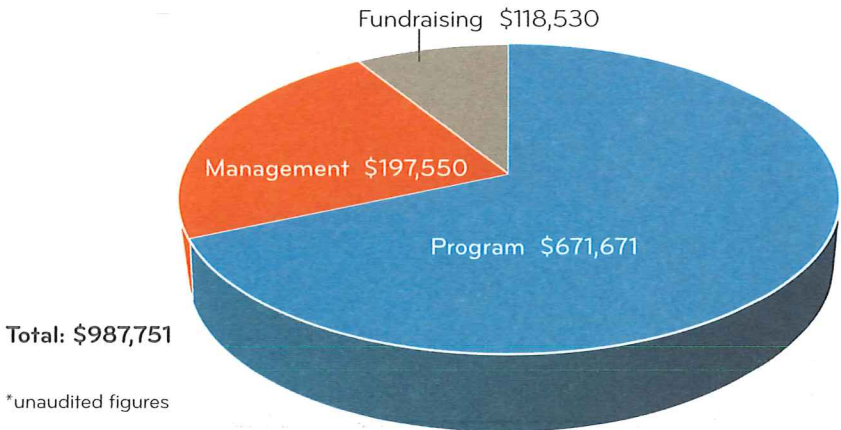
